Meet at 7:45 am at Beatenberg Tourist Center. When you arrive at the alpine cabin, you'll be able to ask the dairyman questions how alpine cheese is made during your dairy tour. Afterwards you'll get a chance to taste some of the delicious cheese as part of an alpine dairyman's breakfast. This visit to the idyllic Justistal is fun for young and old alike.
