Don't be afraid of livestock guarding dogs. In this course, experts from various fields explain how to behave correctly towards livestock guarding dogs.

The Lucerne hiking trails proactively counteract these and are committed to safety when hiking. Course content:

- Large carnivores and livestock guarding dogs: behavior, training, working methods, etc.
- Correct behavior of people during an encounter: planning (maps), information boards in the area, behavior tips and no-gos, risk of companion dogs, strategy in case of fear, etc.
- Safe encounters with the livestock guarding dog in the field
- Simulation of a conflict situation if necessary
- Accompanying a person with fear
