At 2,350 m above sea level, the Brienzer Rothorn towers over the Entlebuch and, to the astonishment of many, is the highest mountain in Canton Lucerne.

1 mountain - 693 neighbours. With optimal visibility, you can enjoy the view of 693 mountain peaks and the turquoise-blue Lake Brienz on the Brienzer Rothorn. The brand-new aerial cableway from Sörenberg takes guests up to this impressive panoramic mountain in 7 minutes. Coffee tastes particularly delicious on the terrace of the Rothorn summit restaurant. Chances are good that the king of the Alps - the ibex - will cross your path or the mountain jackdaws will circle above your heads.
