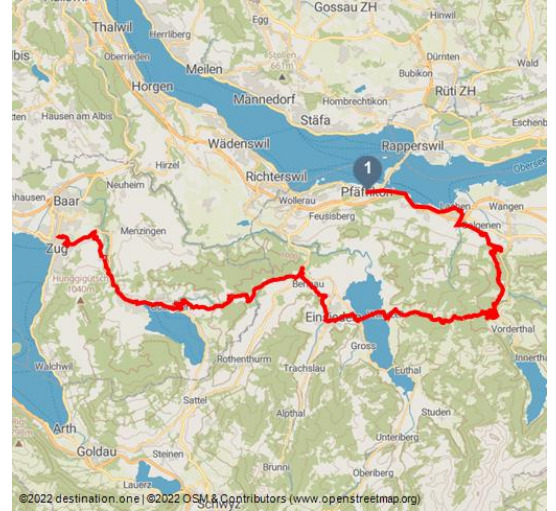











Pfäffikon SZ - Sattellegg - Zug

This is quite a scenic ride to be done either early in the season or when you don't have enough time to head out for a full day ride. On sunny weekends there can be a considerable amount of traffic on the Sattellegg and Raten passes.

The tour starts off on the main road from Pfäffikon to Lachen, but fortunately there is a bicycle lane for much of the way. In Lachen it's possible to get away from the traffic and use some not very frequented roads to get to Sonne via Vorderberg. Once in Sonne we hit Sattelleggpass properly and climb through some almost Alpine style hairpins for the first few hundred metres of the climb. Once over the top there is a nice descent to Willerzell before we cross the bridge to Einseideln and ride through the town. Once again we can take quiet roads to Biberbrugg where we start the short climb to the Ratenpass. A coffee overlooking the Aegerisee at the Ratenpass gives some time to take in

the amazing views of the valley and surrounding mountains before starting the descent to Zug.

Parking:
