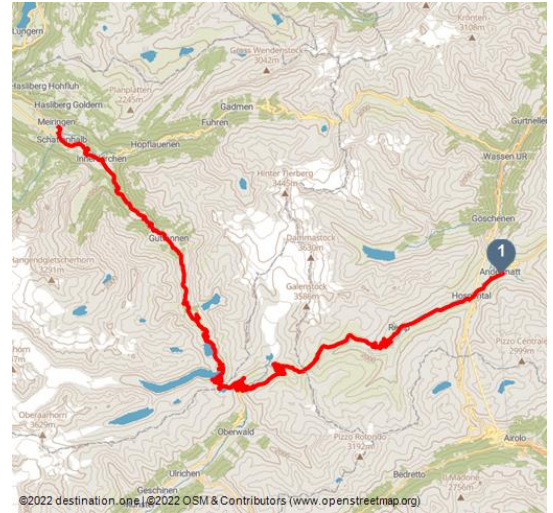




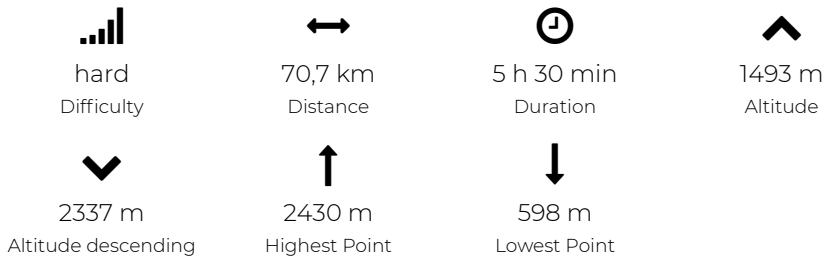
Route 1291, stage 3: Andermatt – Meiringen

Three highlights feature today on stage three of Route 1291: #from Andermatt, the route heads up and over the Furka and Grimsel passes then down to Meiringen, passing the Aare gorge.

Enjoy the third stage of Route 1291: you'll be negotiating two world-famous passes today plus other highlights along the way. From Andermatt, you pedal through the pristine Urseren valley and through Realp before reaching the Furka pass. This is followed by the Grimsel pass and a long descent to Meiringen at alt. 595 metres. Before you get there, you pass the Aare gorge, which is well worth a detour.

Directions:

From Andermatt, the route leads through the Urseren Valley via Realp to the Furka pass. Continue via the Grimsel pass to Meiringen.

On this route, pay attention to the signposting on site. On some sections of the route, fast e-bikes (45s with yellow number) are sometimes prohibited.

Here you will find the traffic signals and their meaning.

When passing through farms, we thank you on behalf of the farmers for passing through at an adapted, reduced speed.

Safety Guidelines:

You are asked to stay on the path and not to enter meadows or pastures.

You also need to pay attention to your safety amongst the traffic.

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Equipent:

- E-bike (incl. spare battery, if possible) and charger for on the road.
- Suitable equipment for your own safety

If you don't have your own e-bike, we recommend Rent a Bike. Rent the right e-bike for you online and pick it up conveniently at Lucerne station.

Tip:

Make the most of the passage over the Furka and Grimsel passes and reflect on the historical past of these routes.

A visit to the Aare gorge offers an impressive natural spectacle – and soothing refreshment on hot summer days.
