



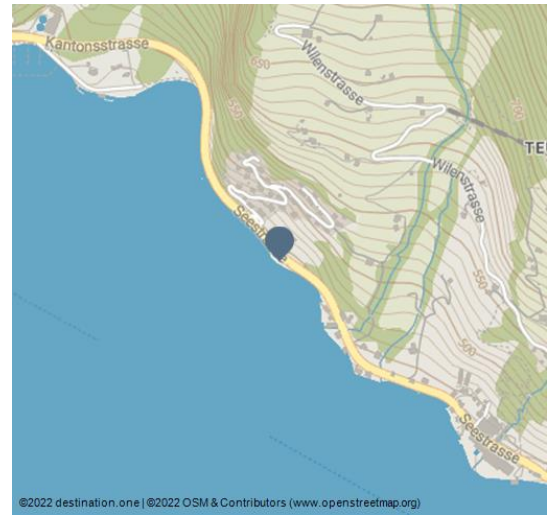

The Brougierpark is named after the German merchant and food company Adolf Brougier. Born in Altensteig, Württemberg in 1844, he spent the last part of his life in Vitznau.

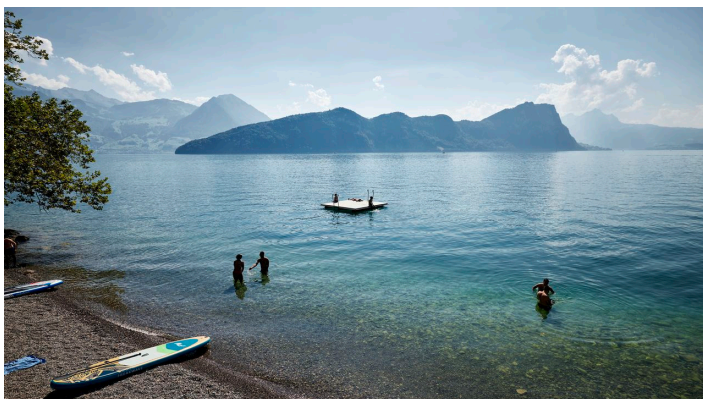

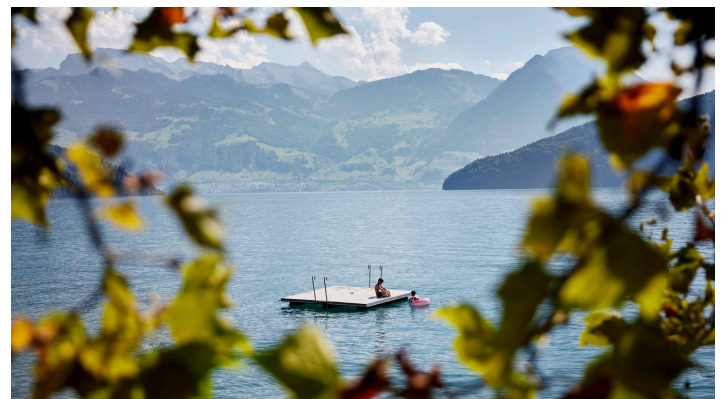
