For this reason, fortifications were built in the mountains as a defense strategy. One such bunker can be found in Beatenbucht on Lake Thun.

Visit the Fischbalmen infantry bunker on a guided tour and learn more about the history of the Reduit.

The guided tour of the fortress lasts around one and a half hours.
