It was dedicated in 1953 on the 500th anniversary of the artist's death.

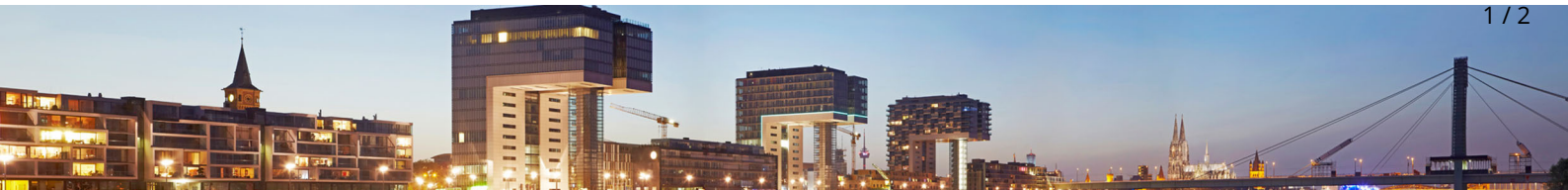
