

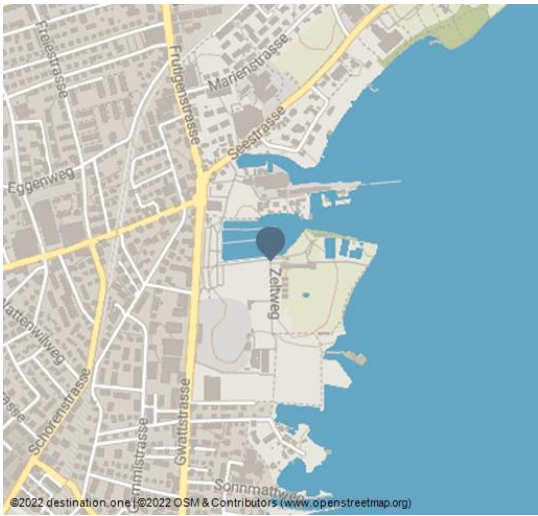

Please note that waste must be cleared up at the end of the trip. When you book a picnic and barbecue package for your group excursion, the charter price includes the grill and the gas.

### Public shuttle service for locals and tourists

The Solar Boat Shuttle Service is a project of the town of Thun in partnership with the Thun solar boat. The water-based shuttle service provides an interesting link between the town centre and the parks by Lake Thun. Take advantage of attractive rates on trips between the lido, Hünibach, Schadau Park and Aare quay. The Solar Boat Shuttle Service operates on weekends from June to September, calling at various stops.
