### Feel the refreshing spray of the waterfall

**Marvel at the towering, jagged and layered rock formations of the Planalp. Enjoy the spectacle of the invigorating Milibach Waterfall tumbling down the sheer rock face.**

Whether hiking up to the Planalp or heading down into the valley after a day's walking on the Brienzer Rothorn, the Milibach Waterfall is well worth a detour. From Brienz, a hiking trail leads along the mountain stream almost as far as the waterfall. The bridge directly overlooks the invigorating mass of water – a refreshingly welcome sight after a long hike. The Milibach Waterfall and the imposing rock formations dominate the village of Brienz, even though a mere trickle of water passes down the rock in warm, dry summers.

### Your highlights at a glance

- Barbecue point at the Gäldried intersection of the Brienzer Rothorn Railway
- The Milibach is especially impressive in the springtime, or after rainfall
- Combine your hike with a refreshing detour to the Milibach Waterfall

- Treat yourself to Chäsbrätel or rösti at the Planalp mountain restaurant
- Check the weather forecast in advance
- The walk from Brienz to the Milibach Waterfall takes around one hour

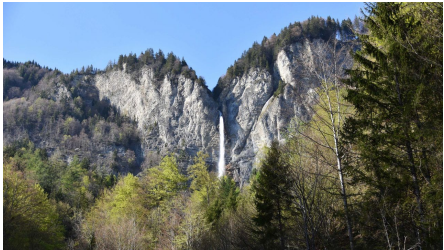
