Solve the hidden riddles and find the treasure chest

The colourful treasure hunt trails in Aeschi promise adventure for the whole family. Your children will be transformed into treasure hunters as they use different clues to guide you through the idyllic landscape. The trail leads you through the village, across colourful flower meadows and past deep-green forests. You and your family will answer various questions along the way.

Join your family on an fun fun-packed treasure trail in Aeschi and search for the mysterious treasure chest. Pick up your treasure map in Aeschi tourist office, then with map in hand set off with your family on the three-hour trail. The easy-going trail passes through flower meadows, green fields and past the forest. Various posts with questions have been hidden along the way. The «Crack the combination lock» trail is a real adventure for children aged 8 and above. To open the treasure chest, you will need sharp eyes and mathematical skill: only those who get the calculations right will crack the combination. For younger treasure hunters, the shorter «Seeholzwald» route is ideal: with interesting questions to answer on the forest and the local area, fun and excitement are guaranteed. If you answer all of the questions correctly, expect to be rewarded with a sweet surprise. Place answer cards in the "Chäs-Chessi" cheese cauldron in the tourist office. If the tourist office is closed, you can hand in your answers at the kiosk (by the large car park in the village). The main draw is held at the end of the year, with great prizes for all the family.
