Visit the fascinating ruins of the historic castle

The gunpowder tower can already be seen from a distance. Climb up the stone staircase to Strättligburg to enjoy the view over the deep-blue waters of Lake Thun. Not only that: The tower and courtyard make unusual venues for special occasions and are available for hire.

The medieval ruins above Gwatt date from the 13th century and are all that's left of the ancestral seat of the Barons of Strättligen. After the castle was destroyed, a gunpowder tower was built in 1699. Take a walk to the historic ruins and the imposing tower to enjoy the view over Lake Thun. Strättligburg is one of the most unusual events venues in Thun, and the tower and courtyard with covered fire pit can be hired for a special occasion.
