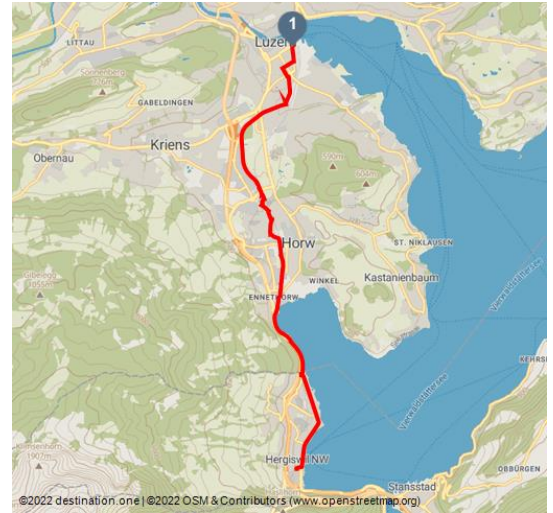




Luzern – Nidwalden: cycle tour by the lake
